

There are 3 rooms: Men's, Women's and Children's

The Clothing Closet Volunteers

- To limit exposure there will only be one volunteer on duty for each room that is open.
- The volunteer will wear a face mask and gloves and will have sanitizer, gloves and face masks for each shopper before they enter the room
- If a volunteer, or someone in their home, is diagnosed with Covid-19, they will not be allowed to continue to volunteer at the Clothing Closet until they have had a 14-day quarantine and a negative COVID test. The entire room will be sanitized before it is opened again (it is only open once a week, on Saturday afternoons).

The Clothing Closet Shoppers –

- There will be no more than 2 “shoppers” and 1 worker in a room at a time.
- If the 2 shoppers are not from the same household, they will be reminded to maintain 6’ of distancing from each other.
- Before they enter the room, shoppers will be instructed to place any items that they touch but do not take (including clothing) in baskets/bins placed on the floor in each section of the room.
- If a ‘shopper’ refuses to wear a mask or gloves, they will not be allowed to enter the room.
- Basic screening questions regarding exposure, symptoms, positive test, will be asked. If the answer is yes to any, they will not be allowed to enter the room.

If ‘shoppers’ cannot enter for whatever reason, if they need a specific item that we have, the volunteer may get the item, bag it and bring it out of the room for the ‘shopper.’

Cleaning

- The Clothing Closet Rooms and Contents – Floors, doors, door knobs, thermostats, all shelving and hard surfaces have been sanitized in advance of the reopen.
- While the Clothing Closet is open (Saturday afternoons), hard surfaces, shelves and items touched by shoppers and placed in the baskets/bins on the floor will be sanitized after the shoppers have left the room and before the next two shoppers enter the room.
- The volunteer on duty will be responsible to complete the sanitizing, using a fresh mixture of water and color-fast bleach spray to avoid damaging the clothing.
- All Clothing Closet volunteers will be instructed on how to sanitize the room and must be committed to the precautions which must be taken to stop the spread of Covid-19: Wearing face masks; washing hands, using sanitizer and wearing gloves; maintaining social distance of at least six feet; and sanitizing facilities and contents used by people who may have been exposed to the virus (virtually everyone).
